It's an offence to purchase or attempt to purchase alcohol if you're under 18.



Staff have been instructed that if you look under 21 years of age, you'll be asked to show identification (driving licence photocard, passport, cards having the PASS hologram) proving you are 18 years old or older when you buy alcohol.
